

**Letter and Information Sent to the NWSPNC Board by the Pacific Palisades Residents Association (PPRA)**

Dear NW San Pedro NC Board:

Pacific Palisades Residents Association (PPRA) is a 50-year-old, all-volunteer non-profit organization dedicated to preserving our residential neighborhoods and protecting our community's environment.

Over the past several months, PPRA has been investigating the issue of cell tower proliferation throughout Los Angeles. We have been working with our Councilmember Bill Rosendahl (CD 11) as well as a coalition of concerned citizens and groups in regard to changes in cell tower/antenna regulation in Los Angeles.

This issue will soon be taken up (possibly as early as September 16) by the Public Works Committee, which is now chaired by Councilmember Jose Huizar. Councilmembers Greig Smith and Richard Alarcon are also members.

We understand that your district may have experienced problems with cell tower siting, particularly in residential neighborhoods, in the recent past. We are writing to NCs and homeowner/improvement associations in your district to let you know what we've learned and what we and others have been doing in regard to cell tower proliferation and regulation. We urge you and your members to consider joining other citizens, public officials and NCs/CCs throughout the City in supporting needed changes in Los Angeles' regulation of cell towers. Information about steps you can take to assist in the effort is contained in the FAQs sheet.
